- After retirement, 1980 to 1985: Sold textile business factory and shop, moved to village and started to help poor families and school students, providing clothes, shoes, and school fees. Installed electric motor for water supply in high school. Also, each and every month on Sangrand (new month), did Bhog of Sahij Path (Guru Granth Sahib) at home and offered 1 ½ karraha (a large frying pan) of Parsad (pudding) free to all schools and poor kids. On his last journey, funeral procession, lots of kids followed and said “Parsad wala baba gone”.
